

Quest at IAAPA in Atlanta Georgia

Quest with their partner in the USA, Icon Software Inc, exhibited VersaTerm, Task Connect and the Kitchen Monitor System at the International Association of Amusement Parks and Attractions (IAAPA) Exhibition and Convention in November 2000. IAAPA represents over 5,600 facilities in 91 Countries covering such attractions as Theme Parks, Water Parks, Zoo's, Aquariums and Museums etc. More information on the organization can be obtained from www.iaapa.org.

The exhibition was held at the Georgia World Congress Centre, in the heart of Atlanta. This facility covers over 2.5 million square feet, with 950,000 square feet of exhibition space and also uses the adjacent Georgia Dome home to the Atlanta Falcons football team. This is a fully covered 71,500 seat stadium with another 102,000 square feet of exhibition space.

David Brown represented quest and Icon had representatives from their Los Angeles, Seattle & Denver offices as well as their Mexican Office.

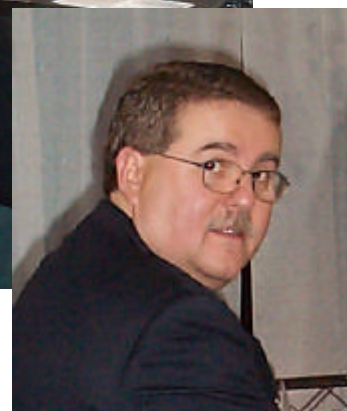
